## St Raphael's Stars Basketball Club ( referred to as SRSBC ) Club registration and fee payment policy V2 21 3 17

1. Summer and Winter seasonal fees are assessed and set by the SRSBC Committee for the coming season and may be increased from time to time
2. The fees paid by players / parents cover:
  - Registration with Coburg Basketball Association
  - Player insurance
  - Court rental for team practise sessions
  - General costs associated with running the club
  - Provision and maintenance of singlets, balls and club assets
  - Provision for the future development of the club
3. After expressing an interest to an SRSBC official to play in a coming season, a new or existing player has to pay their seasonal fees in full to be considered for selection.
4. Registration Day occurs twice a year and information related to the two dates will be listed on the SRSBC club website well in advance of the events occurring. Instructions on how to pay and information related to the various payment methods are listed on the club website.
5. Payment of seasonal fees must be completed prior to round 1 of the coming season.
6. Payment of fees defines a player as being a financial player. An existing financial player will be able to play in his / her team or a new financial team selected or allocated to a team.
7. Prospective players who fail to pay their fees by the registration day / due date of the coming season will be deemed to be a non financial person and will not be selected to play in a team.
  - 7.1 A non financial persons place on his or her team will then be allocated to other financial players.
  - 7.2 Late payment of fees will not guarantee a financial player will be allocated to his or her previous seasons team.
8. Under no circumstances is a non financial person to play a game for SRSBC.
8. Some families may find paying a seasons fees in full difficult and may prevent a player taking part in a basketball team. At the discretion of the SRSBC Treasurer, a payment plan may be entered into to assist those who require this payment method. A player will be considered financial once the first instalment has been received.
9. Players who fail to maintain a payment plan payment schedule will be deemed non financial and will not be able to play with his or her team until payments are up to date as per the payment schedule.
10. Any money owed to SRSBC by a player from previous seasons will deem the player to be non financial and he or she will not be considered for team selection until all monies owed are paid in full
11. Issues or disputes related to the payment of fees need to be communicated in writing to the SRSBC Treasurer who will raise the issue with the SRSBC Committee for management and adjudication. The official email address to use is [straphsbasketball@gmail.com](mailto:straphsbasketball@gmail.com)
12. Once a payment has been made, players / parents are not entitled to any refund of season fees
13. From time to time, SRSBC teams may require a non financial player to play as a fill in player. A fill in player is only able to play a maximum of twice in one season.
